



How to play Go Fish!

- 1 Shuffle cards. Spread them out facedown in a central drawpile. Each player takes 6 cards from the pile. (Hold cards with notch in upper right corner)
- 2 If you have any sets (4 of the same color fish), lay them down faceup in front of you. All players do the same.
- 3 The youngest player starts. Play continues to the left.

- *On your turn:* Call out a color fish in your hand! Try to complete a set by asking any player to give you all cards of the called-out color he or she holds. For example, if you have 2 blue cards and need 2 more, ask a player, "Do you have any blue fish?"

If you get a card(s), then ask anyone again.

If you don't get a card(s), the called-on player says "Go Fish!" Then take a card from the drawpile. If you draw the color you asked for, show it, and then ask any player again for any color fish; if you don't draw the color you asked for, add the card to your hand and your turn is over.

NOTE: Any time you complete a set, lay it down.

- *The Winner:* After all 10 sets have been laid down, the game is over. The player with the most sets wins!
